

**NOGALES HIGH SCHOOL

IN MWD'S SOLAR CUP COMPETITION!**

Metropolitan Water District hosted the seventh annual *Solar Cup* competition at Lake Skinner in Temecula, May 15, 2009, through May 17, 2009. This three-day event is the nation's largest solar boat competition at the high school or college level.

Thirty-two (32) schools and nearly 1,000 students throughout Southern California competed in sprint races down a 200-meter course with solar charged batteries powering the boat, and on a 90-minute endurance race around a 2-kilometer course with solar panels attached to their 16-foot hulls.

Rowland Water District's own, Nogales High School (La Puente) won Second Place in Technical Reports and Third Place in the *Solar Endurance*. Congratulations to Mr. Ezekiel Chavez and his physics scholars for a job well done!
